

1 a roll call vote is called for, will under the rules be
2 by the electric vote callboard. The procedure in each
3 instance will be for the presiding officer to throw the
4 switch, which rings a bell just in front of the rostrum.
5 That is your signal to vote even though you don't hear the
6 presiding officer's announcement. Before the record is
7 taken, the presiding officer will ask if everyone has
8 voted, and will ask if any Delegate desires to change his
9 vote, giving opportunity for Delegates to change, simply
10 by pushing the other button. After reasonable opportunity,
11 the presiding officers will tell the Clerk to record the
12 vote. The Clerk will push another switch, and at that
13 point, you can no longer operate your switch. You cannot
14 change your vote. The vote will then be recorded mechanic-
15 ally on a punched paper, which then becomes a part of the
16 records of the Convention.
