representative of all trainmen in Maryland, including employees of the Balitmore and Ohio Railroad, the Pennsylvania Railroad, the Western Maryland Railway Company, the Patapsco and Back River Railroad, and the Canton Railroad. He also represents the Baltimore and Annapolis Railroad trainmen and bus drivers and the Baltimore Motor Coach Drivers. His duties have been full time during all sessions of the General Assembly.

"Mr. Ritter served two years in the South
Pacific with the U. S. Army during World War II. He
is a member of the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign
Wars, the Elk and the Masonic bodies of Cumberland.
He is married to the former Margaret Courtney of Cumberland, and the couple are the parents of two married
