

1 Chairman of the Committee and the majority of the Committee
2 construes power to sign a bill as being one of the duties
3 of the Governor that could be delegated to the Lieutenant
4 Governor.

5 Could I ask a question if that is a correct
6 understanding?

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Morgan, do you follow
8 the inquiry?

9 DELEGATE MORGAN: Mr. Chairman, that was the
10 statement that I made yesterday.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: I am not clear as to what your
12 statement was. If you would repeat so that we will all
13 understand.

14 DELEGATE MORGAN: That the Governor delegate any
15 of his duties to the Lieutenant Governor and among the
16 duties, as an example of the duties he could delegate would
17 be the duty to veto bills.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gleason's question as I
19 understand it is Section 4.16 specifically says that a bill
20 shall become law if the Governor signs or fails to veto it.
