2 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gleason.

3 DELEGATE GLEASON: This is what I wanted to get  
4 very, very clear, that your amendment will not cast any  
5 doubt or modification with respect to Section 4.07. It just  
6 applies to Section 4.03, is that correct?

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Chabot.

8 DELEGATE CHABOT: That is correct.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gleason.

10 DELEGATE GLEASON: Then, Mr. Chairman, I do think  
11 this is a very fundamental change that has to be made in this  
12 provision. I have to agree with the Sponsor of this amend-  
13 ment that, where we are dealing with an act of the legis-  
14 lature, we are dealing with the Governor's participation in  
15 that act. We are dealing with something that almost partakes  
16 of a sacred nature with respect to a bill becoming law and I  
17 do not think that any Lieutenant Governor should be delegated  
18 this kind of power for the convenience of the Governor, just  
19 because he happens to be temporarily out of Annapolis or out  
20 of the State making a speech some place. Even though we are  
21 providing in this section for a Lieutenant Governor, I don't
