2 section relating to the powers and duties of successor, both
3 words are used together, to indicate, perhaps, that more is
4 meant by one than the other.

5 I am wondering if a Constitutional power, which
6 I would conceive of the Governor's veto being, whether that
7 really could be under the language which seems to make a
8 distinction between the word "power" and "duties", could be
9 delegated under the word "duties" in Section 4.03?

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Morgan.

11 DELEGATE MORGAN: Delegate Marion, it seems to
12 me that the performance of the duties is really the exercise
13 of one of the delegated powers. I really can't see the
14 distinction between the two.
