2 DELEGATE SICKLES: I would like to address it to
3 the Sponsor, Delegate Chabot.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: First, does anyone desire to speak
5 in opposition?

6 Delegate Dukes.

7 DELEGATE DUKES: Just a question of Delegate
8 Morgan.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Sickles will be permitted
10 to ask his question first.

11 Delegate Chabot, do you yield to a question?

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Sickles.

14 DELEGATE SICKLES: I think it is perfectly clear
15 when you look at the memorandum in support of the recommenda-
16 tion of the Committee that the interpretation of the Chairman
17 is accurate, because we say here, on page 4, and I will read
18 it to you, line 29: "Hence, for example, the Governor could,
19 if he chooses, delegate to the Lieutenant Governor power to
20 veto bills, to call out the militia, or to fire department
21 heads."
