2 by including the expression just before the word, "such
3 other duties", by including the expression, "unless
4 prohibited by law, such other duties as may be delegated
5 to him by the Governor." That was the only point to which
6 I was speaking.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: May I then direct the inquiry I
8 made to the Chairman of the Committee, and ask him whether
9 it is the intent of Section 4.03 that the effect of the
10 first sentence would be to authorize the legislature to take
11 away from the Governor and delegate to the Lieutenant
12 Governor any powers or duties of the Office of Governor.

13 Delegate Morgan.

14 DELEGATE MORGAN: Mr. Chairman, that was not the
15 intention of the Committee.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: It seems to the Chair that the
17 language may be susceptible of that interpretation.

18 Delegate Chabot, do you wish to comment further
19 with respect to Delegate Sickles' suggestion to you as to
20 your amendment? He has pointed out where he would make the
21 change.
