3 DELEGATE CHABOT: I really think that if that is  
4 a question, it is a question to be answered by the Committee  
5 Chairman. As I said, I would like to be able to read that  
6 interpretation into these words. I think that this body has  
7 been foreclosed from reading that interpretation into it.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Clagett.

9 DELEGATE CLAGETT: Mr. Chairman, I have a question  
10 I would like to ask Delegate, the Chairman of the Committee,  
11 Delegate Morgan. Where the provision is made in Section 4.03,  
12 that the Lieutenant Governor shall perform such duties as  
13 may be prescribed by law, is it not the intent of the Committee  
14 and the meaning of the language that the legislature can  
15 only delegate to the Lieutenant Governor by law such duties  
16 as it may have the power under this Constitution to delegate  
17 to him, which means that it could not delegate to him the  
18 powers granted to the Executive under 4.01, but could only  
19 delegate to him such powers as it had under 3.01, or other-  
20 wise, there would be a violation of the difference between  
21 the branches of government.
