2 the duties, whereupon the Lieutenant Governor becomes Acting  
3 Governor.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Penniman.

5 DELEGATE PENNIMAN: It seems to me that more  
6 questions are raised than simply the ones which surround the  
7 immediate problem of the veto, because there are provisions  
8 in other Articles which are subject to the same kind of prob-  
9 lems as the ones that Delegate Chabot is now talking about.  
10 For example, in Article 3, Section 12, there is a provision  
11 that the Governor shall have the authority to convene the  
12 legislature in special session.

13 I wonder if I could get the Chairman of the  
14 Committee on the Legislative Branch, if I could ask Delegate  
15 Gallagher a question.

16 Was it the intention of the Legislative Branch  
17 that the Governor should be able to delegate the authority  
18 to call special sessions of the legislature to the  
19 Lieutenant Governor.
