

1 the performance of his duties, and that is the primary thing,
2 and that the legislature would naturally have the power to
3 assign such other duties of an incidental character as they
4 may desire, like sitting on boards or something like that.

5 The primary thing is for the Governor to select
6 which powers or duties should be exercised by one or the
7 other. If that is the primary concern, then that disturbs
8 me very much, because I don't think that is what this
9 Convention has approved or wants to approve.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Storm.

11 DELEGATE STORM: Mr. Chairman, when this was
12 in Committee, I really had a fairly narrow definition for
13 duties, somewhat like the Dictionary, and I have been
14 sincerely worried about this. I know a lot of folks thought
15 I was joking but I really have been concerned about it and
16 I was wondering if perhaps our Committee might reconsider
17 this particular section a little in our own meeting, because
18 I am afraid it does open the way up for unexpected action
19 by the Legislature. There are so many questions
20 raised with the interchange of the words "powers" and
21 "duties" and in the majority commentary that I wish we
