

1 THE CHAIRMAN: I don't think we need to take
2 consent. We can see where we are at recess.

3 May the Chair, since the discussion has taken this
4 turn, echo the same concern that I think Delegate Henderson
5 was echoing, and indicate there is considerable doubt as to
6 the position expressed by Delegate Clagett in view of the
7 specific language of Sections 4.18, 4.19, 4.20 and following,
8 which does indeed give the legislature very broad powers
9 with respect to the Executive Branch.

10 I merely mention that so it would be in the
11 Committee's mind.

12 Delegate Chabot, in view of the suggestion that
13 has been made, would you be willing to withdraw your amend-
14 ment from consideration now, with the assurance from the
15 Chair that you will have the opportunity to offer it again
16 when Section 4.03 is under consideration?

17 DELEGATE CHABOT: Mr. Chairman, I rose to do just
18 that. Of course, I will agree.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: All right. Let the Amendment
20 retain its Number 12. It is withdrawn at the present time.
21 It will be offered again later.
