11 area in a principal department of the State which should be
12 headed by a board other than education, I can't quite see it,
13 and I would be opposed to it as an individual.

16 everybody knows, the difference between this report in
17 regard to the **present** Majority Report is that there could be
18 no boards, they would all have to be principal departments
19 under your Minority Report, all headed by a department head
