2 approval to do what he wants to do only in the executive
3 branch, only under reorganizational programs and if they do
4 not approve of this, they have fifty days to study it and
5 turn it down. Now, the difference is with the Majority
6 Report that, as I say, if you look at the temporary provision
7 that is set up for Section 4.18, you will see that what I am
8 afraid of, Delegate Raley, is that the legislature might
9 wait the necessary two years if the people of this State see
10 fit to -- have you got it?

11 DELEGATE CLARK: Delegate Raley.

12 DELEGATE RALEY: Yes.

13 DELEGATE CLARK: The Chair would suggest now that
14 Delegate Boyce has agreed to withdraw his amendments
15 temporarily to allow Delegate Maurer to offer hers and then
16 the discussion could be on these amendments.
