2 Now, you can split them apart and this would
3 require, I would take it, statutes to do. So that would be
4 the kind of case we are talking about.

5 Then you go on to say they shall be set forth in
6 an executive order, and so on.

7 Now, that executive order, you say, which reorga-
8 nizes the Department of Budget Procurement , would not be
9 "law" and yet, it is the kind of thing that the
10 Constitution implies to me requires law. I think it is
11 inconsistent.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Morgan.

13 DELEGATE MORGAN: Mr. Chairman, that is the very
14 kind of thing that the language Delegate Case was referring
15 to was intended to color.

16 Here it sets up the Department of Budget and
17 Procurement and the government wants to reorganize and split
18 it into two departments. Now, that reorganization will
19 change a law and in that sense will have the force and
20 effect of law and this simply says to do that the Governor
21 has to submit an executive order accomplishing it to the
