6 it is limited, the Governor is then limited to those changes,
7 is that correct?

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Adkins.

9 DELEGATE ADKINS: I would certainly say that this
10 is this Member's understanding of the intention. It was, I
11 think not -- no, it was not my intention and, of course, I
12 can't speak for the Committee. It was not my intention that
13 the Governor should have any power to create new programs
14 as Senator James has said or new functions, but was simply
15 given the power to reorganize the effective execution of such
16 existing programs.
