2 would set up at that time, we will say, a Department of
3 Motor Vehicles to handle the registration of the cars and
4 the registration and licensing of drivers. Then they would
5 have created a function, prescribe a function and set up an
6 agency to handle it.

7 Now, the Governor would then be able to take that
8 Department of Motor Vehicles and put it in one big licensing
9 bureau that would license everything, lawyers, doctors,
10 drivers, motor vehicles, and so on. He would not be able to
11 change the requirement that licenses be required of drivers
12 or that registration be required of cars.

13 Does this explain the difference? 4.18 is
14 absolutely necessary because that gives the legislature the
15 right to pass the laws and establish the programs and the
16 big legislative policies.

17 4.19 says and repeats that the legislature shall
18 do this and then it says the Governor **may** make changes in
19 the organization of the Executive Branch, and we had an
20 argument over the next part "including the establishment or
21 abolition of principal departments and the assignment of
