2 THE CHAIRMAN: Hereafter, in recognizing Delegate
3 Taylor, the Chair will pause for a moment to ascertain
4 which Taylor.

5 In further answer to your earlier question, I might
6 say that the Staff inquired of the Attorney General very
7 early in the session whether Delegates and employees could
8 be covered by Workmens' Compensation. The Attorney General
9 suggested in his reply that the work of the Delegates is
10 not extra hazardous.

12 DELEGATE L. TAYLOR: I would like to rise in
13 support of my Fellow Delegate H. E. Taylor.

14 I had an experience when I worked for the
15 Department of Public Welfare. I leaned back in my chair
16 and slipped. I didn't get paid for about a month, but
17 finally, I got my compensation check for falling on the
18 floor.
