

1 Governor having the veto and the legislative having the  
2 power to pass the bill?

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Maurer.

4 DELEGATE MAURER: Either.

5 The legislature could use the routine procedure  
6 subject to veto and then the Governor could initiate a  
7 reorganization plan subject to veto in the legislature, but  
8 that the Governor could not create a new program but he  
9 could only reorganize existing functions, but that the  
10 legislature could also create new programs.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Hickman.

12 DELEGATE HICKMAN: You are referring to Section  
13 4.18 at the present time, is that correct?

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Maurer.

15 DELEGATE MAURER: Yes, sir.
