2 going to be our principal departments, and I think if you
3 want a properly run and managed state we are not going to
4 have boards as heads of departments, and I think if we could
5 as a Convention approve this, I think we would solve the
6 biggest problem I worry about in the minority reports.

7 And if this went through before the amendments
8 in 19 and 4.20 I think we would solve other problems and
9 I think I could get the rest of the minority members to
10 withdraw this report if we went through.

11 I don't mean this as a threat. Even if the
12 vote is decisive we won't bring it up, but I would like to
13 have a chance while discussing this to get my members of
14 that minority report to go and see if they wouldn't agree
15 to this.
