

to repeat the exceptance of both divisions.

1 THE CHAIRMAN: I don't think so. I think her
2 amendment is to leave that to law. She is not attempting
3 to fix that in the Constitution, as I understand it.

4 Is that correct, Delegate Maurer?

5 DELEGATE MAURER: Yes, sir. That would come
6 under 4.21, when we debate 4.21, if we pass 4.20, is that
7 not correct? Because the chief administrative officers are
8 not dealt with in 4.20.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: That is correct.

10 Delegate Pullen.

11 DELEGATE PULLEN: May I make the point to my
12 colleague that if that is left in there, without that
13 protective device, the purpose, the appointment could be
14 made by some other agency, and by provision of the
15 legislature.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: That is exactly what Delegate
17 Maurer intends as the Chair understands it.

18 Delegate Pullen, you will have the opportunity
19 to offer an amendment to that. That is the effect of the
20 section at the present time, I might point out.

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
