

1 standing from the testimony of Delegate Morgan yesterday
2 that there is the possibility that one of the departments
3 in this new system which is to be decided by the General
4 Assembly at a later date might be Health, Education and
5 Welfare, and it just seems to me that this amendment is
6 assuming that education will be a principal department.

7 I just wanted you to clarify that.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Maurer.

9 DELEGATE MAURER. Mrs. Key, it is my understanding
10 or interpretation that this does not mandate the Univer-
11 sity of Maryland as a principal department, but in the
12 event that the state public school system or the university
13 of Maryland should be set up as a principal department, then
14 the head of that department would really be, or could be
15 a board, and would not have to come under the single
16 executive to head it.

19 advisability of putting in something into the Constitution
20 that might not be.
