

1 DELEGATE BARD: Mr. Chairman, I like that as
2 a substitution, Delegate Sherbow, and would certainly accept
3 it. At this moment it may well be that it ought to be a
4 parenthetical statement, so that the Committee on Style
5 could use it rather than to have an amendment to an
6 amendment to an amendment.

7 What do you think of that?

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Sherbow.

9 DELEGATE SHERBOW: You asked me a question; I
10 wished we had the power to say all those who are in favor
11 of keeping the school system out completely say yes, those
12 against say no.

13 I wish we had the power to put each of the other
14 sections there. Then we could put it together, because I
15 think this is where we are all in trouble, and Delegate
16 Scanlan has simply pointed it out.

17 DELEGATE BARD: I agree.
