2 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Bard.

3 DELEGATE BARD: I would say that here is where
4 Delegate Maurer and I are as one: namely, we believe that the
5 situation that exists now ought not be tampered with in
6 respect to boards heading up the department.

7 That is correct.

8 Are we freezing it forever, no. The Constitution
9 could be amended on this point, but this point is such an
10 integral basic consideration in higher education that it
11 ought to be made clear in the Constitution.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Morgan.

13 DELEGATE MORGAN: Is it not true that under your
14 amendment you permit boards to head principal departments?

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Bard.

16 DELEGATE BARD: Other than education?

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Morgan.

18 DELEGATE MORGAN: Other than education, yes.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Bard.
