

1 DELEGATE MORGAN: Is it also true that under your
2 amendment the Board of Education could head a principal
3 department?

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Bard.

5 DELEGATE BARD: It might be referred to as a
6 principal department, yes.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Morgan.

8 DELEGATE MORGAN: And then how does it differ
9 from the blue copy?

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Bard.

11 DELEGATE BARD: Delegate Morgan, it differs in the
12 very respect that Delegate Maurer wanted to make clear,
13 namely, that there would be a board which would head it
14 up. This would be the exception.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Morgan, if the Chairman
16 could interrupt, perhaps reaching the end of the colloquy
17 I think Delegate Bard is suggesting a difference. Under
18 the section as it is presently drafted the legislature could
19 provide a single executive as the head of the public
20 school system.

21 Under his amendment the legislature could not
