

1 DELEGATE BARD: This is not correct. What we are
2 saying here is that we would prevent the legislature
3 from setting up one individual, as is made clear, for other
4 principal departments.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Morgan, I think what
6 Delegate Bard is saying is, to adopt your language, he
7 would freeze the present system to the extent that it
8 requires a board at the head of the public school system.

9 He would not freeze it to the extent that the
10 legislature could not change the composition of the board.

11 Delegate Bard.

12 DELEGATE BARD: That is correct.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: I am sorry, Delegate Morgan.

14 DELEGATE MORGAN: Delegate Bard, I think we
15 understand one another.
