

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Morgan.

2 DELEGATE MORGAN: That is correct. I feel tha
3 is very important and as you indicated was in the original
4 committee recommendation and that was supposed to enable
5 the legislature to make the school board or the board of
6 regents with the prestige of the state colleges they
7 wanted to be ahead of, a principal department but now you
8 granted an exception in the beginning of the exception and
9 you say except in the case of the public school system
10 and institutions of higher education, such and such will
11 be the case unless the legislature provides something else
12 by law.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: The Chair suggests that the
14 colloquy that is now going on is not enlightening to the
15 house and is not directed to the question which is presented
16 by the amendment to the amendment.

17 I think I can restate the position in a
18 little more homely terms; if you want to support the com-
19 mittee's recommendation, you would vote for the amendment
20 to the amendment, that would give it half a loaf and if you
21 want to give it the whole loaf you then vote against the
