2 this morning at the session that commenced at 9:15.
3 I would estimate ten or maybe 12. There were a total
4 of about 13 persons who spoke. By way of explanation
5 of the type of publicity, there were the small squibs in
6 the newspaper, as you say.

7 In addition, some delegates I think spoke to
8 people in their home areas and did ask them to come in.
9 Some of these people came in, some declined, and pre-
10 sumably a number of people who want to be heard will
11 be heard at some subsequent time.

12 The committee will commence hearings at
13 12:30 on Monday and at that time the major subject
14 would be the method of granting powers to the counties;
15 that is, whether through expressed powers or the re-
16 sidual powers approach.

17 The persons invited to speak at that time
18 are the Honorable Thomas Hunter Lowe, Dr. Everstine,
19 the Honorable Marvin Mandel, and our President, Mr. Eney.
