DELEGATE SCANLAN: As I was saying, the resolution now before this body is offered to clarify an ambiguity that arose as a result of the message adopted at our organizing session. You will recall the resolution by Delegate Sickles. The Convention approved the authority of the President to engage employees of the Convention and to fix their salaries. It is true that the word, officer, could be assigned to mean different than the word, employee; but I think the general intent at the time was to permit you to engage officers under the same authority that the Convention had bestowed on you to engage employees, but if there is any doubt about it, let's put it to rest. This resolution would authorize you to engage the Secretary, the Chief Clerk, the Sergeant at Arms, the Parliamentiarian, and the Historian, and such other officers as may be required in the future, and I
