

1 Resolution No. 10 will be offered relating to the death
2 of Delegate Ralph Webster. I move that the rules be sus-
3 pended so that Resolution No. 10 in its appropriate place
4 on the agenda may be considered today, without laying
5 over, and I further move that the Calendar and Agenda be
6 adopted.

7 (Whereupon the motion was duly seconded.)

8 THE PRESIDENT: It has been suggested to the
9 Chair that inasmuch as a suspension of the rules requires
10 the majority of the whole number of elected delegates, that
11 whenever we have a motion for suspension of rules that
12 there be a roll call vote. We will follow that practice
13 from then on. The question arises on the motion to approve
14 the Calendar and suspend the rules to permit discussion
15 and consideration at this session of Resolution No. 10.

16 (Whereupon a roll call vote was taken.)

17 THE PRESIDENT: Has every delegate voted?
18 Does any delegate desire to change his vote? If not,
19 the Clerk will record the vote.

20 There being 136 votes in the affirmative and
21 none in the negative, the rules are suspended, and the
