

1 I feel in retrospect that we ought to give
2 every consideration to try to stay only to general prin-
3 ciples and general guidelines and that these attempts are
4 commendable, but should really be addressed to the wisdom
5 and the intelligence of the commission that draws the
6 plan and at this point, I feel compelled to say that I think
7 in the interest of a brief Constitution, that I would ask
8 the sponsors of these various measures if they would not
9 consider withdrawing them and expect their representa-
10 tives in legislature to make these points at another
11 day, rather than to try to write them into the
12 Constitution.

14 DELEGATE DULANY: Mr. Chairman, I stood up for
15 the purpose of withdrawing the motion, but I would like
16 to say that the reason that it was offered was because
17 in questioning Delegate Gallagher he indicated there was
18 nothing in the guidelines specified in 3.02 which would
19 prevent dividing the county in many parts.
