2 DELEGATE CLARK: Are there any questions of
3 Delegate Gilchrist on the minority report? The Chair recog-
4 nizes Delegate Bamberger.

5 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: Delegate Gilchrist, the
6 language that is proposed by the majority report is that
7 the vote shall be by a majority of all the members of that
8 house. I thought in your presentation you suggested that
9 this would have the same effect as the language of the
10 present Constitution, which is that it be the majority of
11 the whole number of members elected, but the Commission's
12 report indicates that there was a different intention. Do
13 you intend to follow the view, or do you adopt the intention
14 of the Commission's report?

15 DELEGATE GILCHRIST. The number of members in
16 the House is defined by, I think it is 3.04 of the Com-
17 mittee's original recommendations, and I don't see very much
18 distinction between the number of members and the total
19 number of people used in your language.

21 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: The Commission Report says
