

1 former President of the Senate, who spoke a few minutes
2 ago, referring to the squirrel in his house, I would say
3 here only that we have no intention that the squirrels
4 vote in either House.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: You have one-half minute, Dele-
6 gate Hanson.

7 DELEGATE HANSON: We would hope that we would
8 have a situation in which all members would be present and
9 vote, but in the event of the illness of a member, in which
10 there was a 60 to 59 vote, it would seem to me, it would
11 seem to the majority of our committee, that the bill
12 should not die simply because one member happened to be
13 absent, either for causes he could not prevent, or for
14 causes which he in fact developed himself.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gilchrist, you have one
16 and a half minutes you may allocate.

17 DELEGATE GILCHRIST: Mr. Chairman, I believe I
18 would like to use the remaining time to correct one impres-
19 sion left.

20 I suggest that the research of the majority is
21 a little bit inadequate because if you take the combination
