

1 In 4.08 we approved the removal of the Governor and 4.09
2 for the succession of the Governor. In 4.18, for the or-
3 ganization of the Executive Branch and 4.19 the reorgani-
4 zation of the Executive Branch.

5 Those have already been approved and they in-
6 clude constitutional majorities.

7 To come up very soon from the general provisions,
8 General Provision 7 has an amendment to the Constitution
9 which requires a constitutional majority. General Provi-
10 sion 10, impeachment of elected officers, requires a
11 constitutional majority. State Finance Minority Report
12 4(A) is suggesting a constitutional majority for state
13 indebtedness, authorized state indebtedness, with the
14 flexible 25 years included.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: You have one-half minute, Dele-

17 DELEGATE GILL: If we approve the majority report
18 for the simple majority, the other legislation that will be
19 faced by the General Assembly, I think we have built in
20 very important protections for us. The only exception I
21 have is with regard to expelling members from the legislature,
