6 A RESOLUTION expressing the profound regret of
7 the Convention over the untimely death of the Honorable
8 Ralph R. Webster, of Allegany County.

9 The Delegates to the Constitutional Convention
10 of Maryland learned with deep regret of the passing of
11 Honorable Ralph R. Webster on October 2nd, 1967.

12 Mr. Webster was elected a delegate to this
13 Convention from Allegany County, and was sworn in on July
14 11th, 1967, but illness required him to offer his resigna-
15 tion.

16 Ralph R. Webster was born in Somerset County.
17 After attending the public schools in that county, he was
18 graduated from St. John's College, later receiving a
19 master's degree from the University of Maryland and Johns
20 Hopkins Universities. His career in the educational field
21 covered posts in Frederick, Garrett and Allegany Counties,
