

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher.

2 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: Mr. Chairman, I am trying
3 to determine whether or not we might better get the sense
4 of the present practice which we wish to retain by per-
5 haps adding the word, adopted, after amendment, and all
6 amendments adopted shall be in writing. I would ask
7 Delegate Della and Senator James if they believe this
8 would be preferable or would they desire the language as
9 it exists in the amendment?

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Della.

11 DELEGATE DELLA: If the amendment is going to be
12 sent back to the House where the bill originated from,
13 those amendments must be adopted by the second House.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Della, I think the ques-
15 tion goes to a different point. It is not intended that
16 amendments offered and not adopted are required to be
17 attached to the bill, is that correct?

18 DELEGATE DELLA: That is true. They are not
19 adopted. I mean they are not accompanying the bill. Those
20 amendments are not adopted. It is only those amendments that
21 are adopted.
