4 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Kiefer?

5 DELEGATE KIEFER: Mr. President, the Committee
6 on Personal Rights and The Preamble will continue its
7 hearings this afternoon and tomorrow on the subject of due
8 process and equal protection and rights of the poor.

9 In the afternoon a number of delegates who have
10 submitted proposals, and I think there are some twenty-
11 three at the last count that are directly or even remotely
12 concerned with this area, have been invited to come and
13 express their views.
