

1 There is very strong likelihood that we will not
2 need the full time, but the chairman necessarily hopes
3 that we can conclude consideration of all committee recom-
4 mendations by the 12 of December, take a brief recess so
5 that the committees, the staff, and particularly the
6 Committee on Style can very thoroughly and quietly review
7 everything that has been done, and then have the Conven-
8 tion come back again into session for a few days to correct
9 any errors that may have been made, and to adopt the
10 report, finally.

11 The Chair and your officers, and the Chairman
12 of the Committee on Calendar and Agenda believe with the kind
13 of work that we have been having in the recent weeks that it
14 will be possible to follow this kind of schedule and still
15 have a sine die adjournment before Christmas. The Chair
16 therefore requests the Committee on Calendar and Agenda to
17 arrange a meeting at such time as necessary to enable it
18 to present a report on Resolution 19 to the Convention
19 at its session on Monday afternoon.
