4 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: If I did not say it be
5 mandatory and that there should be a literal compliance, I
6 should have said because it was the intention of the Com-
7 mittee that the vote in public session by literally complied
8 with. Thank you.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate James.

10 DELEGATE JAMES: Are we establishing a new legal
11 concept, mandatory, substantial compliance?

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher.

13 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: To the best of our ability
14 we are establishing a concept, and if it is new, so be it.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gleason.

16 DELEGATE GLEASON: Mr. Chairman, just let me say
17 in defense of the Committee's action here, that this action
18 was taken to eliminate one of the arguments that Senator
19 James has raised consistently with respect to the Eastland
20 case.
