

1 "substantial compliance". If the Constitution directs some-
2 thing to be done and it isn't done, I doubt whether that
3 anything short of having this done could be compliance at
4 all. On the other hand, if it is simply a clerical error
5 that he has in mind, something which you might say that
6 would be oversight, might be substantial compliance, but it
7 is not a very happy phrase and I have a little difficulty
8 with it.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: That is the difficulty that caused
10 the Chairman of the Committee to confer with the Chair
11 about the matter and I think we can avoid the use of that
12 term.

14 DELEGATE GLEASON: Mr. Chairman, I don't want
15 to prolong this postponement of this section, nevertheless
16 the postponement will actually expedite the work of this
17 Convention, but I am concerned with the suggestion by the
18 Chair and the suggestion of Delegate Hardwicke because he
19 related it to what in effect is proposed by the Committee
20 in Section 3.18 that we have already gone through in other
21 sections of the Committee's reports on mandating the
