

1 DELEGATE WHEATLEY: Mr. Chairman, I think the
2 intent stated by the Committee was to give advisability and
3 as a result of the question --

4 THE CHAIRMAN: That may be and your question
5 would have been proper while the amendment was under
6 discussion but I say that I hardly think this is proper now.
7 It is a matter of clarification. I think it is a
8 continuation of debate on the amendment.

10 DELEGATE WHEATLEY: Mr. Chairman, I was under
11 the impression the Committee intended to work out a compro-
12 mise on this and, therefore, I would suggest that any comment
13 in order of compromise would be in order.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Make your suggestion to the
15 Committee. I don't want to prolong the session by further
16 colloquy between the Chairman and the Delegates.
