4 anything else about that case, do you?

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Amendment Number 21. The Clerk
6 will read the amendment.

7 MR. QUILLEN: Amendment Number 21 to Committee
8 Recommendation Number LB-2 by Delegate James.

9 On page 5, Section 3.17 Journal and Passage
10 of Bills in lines 4 and 5 strike out the words "and a
11 transcript of its debates"; and in line 6 strike out the
12 words "the transcript" and insert in lieu thereof the word
13 "it".

14 THE CHAIRMAN: The amendment is submitted by
15 Delegate James. Is there a second?

16 DELEGATE BENNETT: Second.
