

1 The last exception, that is, the one at the
2 end of the sentence, does not apply to everything that
3 precludes, but only applies to the two phrases immediately
4 preceding.

5 It does not apply to the phrase beginning at
6 the end of line 31 and continuing in line 32. Gramati-
7 cally it is a poor sentence. It would have to be recon-
8 structed, but with that statement, I think the meaning of
9 the committee is relatively clear.

10 Delegate Gallagher.

11 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: Mr. Chairman, we are working
12 out a complete sentence that will be more appropriately
13 stylized.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Well, if you want, we can pass
15 the amendment and consider another amendment while your
16 staff adviser works on that language.

17 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: Yes.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Lay aside Amendment 22, with the
19 consent of the sponsor, to be taken up later.
