

1 district of Baltimore City, which jumps the Patapsco
2 River, as I recall.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher.

4 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: I don't think it would
5 disturb the form of the third Congressional district,
6 even though there is some water division between the dis-
7 trict. There is also a touching land section of the
8 district, as well, as I understand it.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Wheatley.

10 DELEGATE WHEATLEY: I don't have the map before
11 me. However, it seems to me there are some segments of it
12 that are entirely separated by water. I am not certain
13 of that.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Wheatley, the Chair again
15 suggests to you that there is no body of water in the state
16 of Maryland that is not in a county. The lines usually
17 run through the center of the rivers.

18 Delegate Wheatley.

19 DELEGATE WHEATLEY: Mr. Chairman, I don't quite
20 know what you mean by that, because we have a legislative
21 district, that if we use rivers probably it would be
