

1 DELEGATE RYBCZYNSKI: No, sir. I was going to
2 participate in that business about the third Congressional
3 district of Baltimore City.

4 However, apparently that has been answered.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Case, do you have a
6 question of the sponsor?

7 DELEGATE CASE: Yes, sir.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: State the question.

9 DELEGATE CASE: Delegate Gallagher, who is going
10 to redistrict? Who is going to do the redistricting? In
11 the other section, of course, where we are dealing with
12 the General Assembly, a fairly elaborate plan is asked to
13 be done.

14 How is it to be accomplished under this
15 provision?

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher?

17 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: In my opinion, the only
18 legal way for Congressional districting to be done is to
19 be done by the General Assembly of Maryland, the legisla-
20 ture itself, and no other body.
