

1 DELEGATE CASE: Do you mean to say that the
2 governor could not, or a redistricting commission similar
3 to that established for the General Assembly, could not
4 be provided for here?

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher.

6 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: You could provide for a
7 redistricting commission, but you could never provide
8 in my opinion that the commission plan would become law.

9 Something further must happen, and that is to say
10 the General Assembly must be the final actor in the pro-
11 cess. That is to say, whatever plan is adopted must be a
12 plan that was ultimately adopted by the General Assembly.

13 You could use the commission idea to start it
14 off, or to initiate it.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Case.

16 DELEGATE CASE: Can you tell me what authority
17 there is for that statement? In other words, why can it
18 be one way for the state representative body and cannot be
19 that way for the Federal?

20 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher.
