2 Therefore, adjoining territory would include
3 territorial waters.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher.

5 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: I would think that territory--
6 let me state this, as I understand it. The Chairman has
7 stated that there is no body of water, is that correct,
8 Mr. Chairman, no body of water--

9 THE CHAIRMAN: --that is not included in any
10 county. All county lines, not all, but most county lines,
11 go through the center of rivers or other bodies of
12 water.

13 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: Again I am afraid we are
14 getting into the hassle we had last evening on the
15 question of adjoining, which I am doing my best to avoid
16 at the moment, and I suspect that what Delegate Adkins
17 is about to arise to again.

18 The Supreme Court of the United States had used
19 the word "contiguous" heretofore. I do not know whether
20 or not under that interpretation that they jumped bodies
21 of water, but I suspect they probably did.
