2 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher.

3 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: That is correct.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Beatrice Miller.

5 DELEGATE B. MILLER: May I ask the Chairman
6 a question?

7 THE CHAIRMAN: State your question.

8 DELEGATE B. MILLER: Would the Chairman be
9 willing to take the sentence, which seems to distress so
10 many delegates, out of the statement, the second sentence,
11 beginning with "each district shall consist of adjoining
12 territory and be compact in form"?

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher.

14 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: Delegate Miller, I think
15 that since I am only one of 20 on this amendment, that
16 I cannot speak for the other 20. If the other 20 would
17 allow me to speak for them, I presumably would work out
18 something but I suggest we are just drafting, and on the
19 floor here, it seems to me, an amendment which might well
20 be reconsidered by all the sponsors together to get their
21 combined interpretation of it.
