

1 my knowledge that has a provision which is supposed to be
2 like the one proposed, California. Many states have
3 restriction on dual officeholding, and of course we have a
4 restriction or two on that type of limited conflict of
5 interest area. Apparently only one state has a grant to
6 act in this field. That is California. I asked the staff
7 to produce this particular clause, but when we went to the
8 California Constitution we couldn't find it so I don't know
9 exactly what it says. They are the only state that has
10 anything like that. I would gather from what Mr. Margolis
11 said that that wouldn't apply in California. The California
12 legislation has plenary power.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: The Chair can clarify the status
14 in Florida a little bit. A proposed new constitution was
15 drafted by a commission, submitted to the legislature, which
16 has not acted upon it.

19 interested in what you have said that these things are
20 meaningless, that conflict of interest doesn't amount to
21 anything, but we have been talking all afternoon about the
