

1 MR. QUILLEN: Amendment No. 24 to Committee  
2 Recommendation LB-2 by Delegate Moser, on page 5, Section  
3 3.17 (A) Title "Special Legislation" in line 38 after the  
4 word "applicable" strike out the comma and the rest of  
5 the sentence in lines 38 through 40 inclusive.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: The amendment is submitted by  
7 Delegate Moser. Is there a second.

9 The amendment having been seconded, the Chair  
10 recognizes Delegate Moser to speak to the amendment. Are

14 DELEGATE MOSER: Mr. Chairman, this amendment  
15 has been offered after discussion with Chairman Gallagher.  
16 It is by way of being a clarifying amendment. The effect  
17 of it would cause Section 3.17 (A) on Special Legislation  
18 to read simply, "The General Assembly shall pass no special  
19 law when a general law is applicable." It deletes the  
20 phrase "and whether a general law is applicable shall be a  
21 matter for judicial interpretation." The reason for the
