2 DELEGATE FOX: The point I want to make is that
3 I don't see any necessity for this section in this Article
4 at all or else there is no necessity for the local govern-
5 ment provisions that has been put in. We only need one
6 of them. By having both of them, I am afraid we are
7 causing confusion.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Your comment, however, is not
9 directed to the amendment particularly, as I take it?

10 DELEGATE FOX: Unfortunately, no, it is directed
11 to the whole section which is what should be deleted.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes. Is there any further
13 discussion? Are you ready for the question?

16 adoption of the Amendment 25. A vote Aye is a vote in
